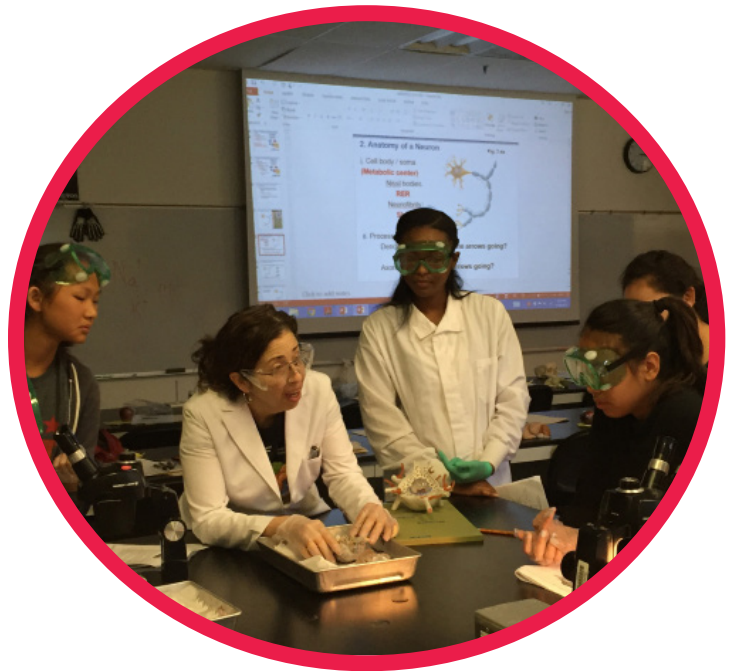

2016 - 2017 ANNUAL REPORT



Flexibility and change were the names of the game in 2016-17 at Girls Inc. of the Island City. With the implementation of full day kindergarten throughout the Alameda Unified School District, we managed the impact on our ALK programs. With the closure of Lum Elementary school, we said goodbye to three of our programs and did our best to support our students and families in their upcoming 2017-18 transition to new schools. Throughout all of this change, we did what we do best: offer quality programs to the best of our ability to almost 1000 students, girls, and boys.

We continued to improve and expand our curriculum and offerings, piloting revised Girls Inc. National Economic Literacy programs and attending trainings on the newly revised Preventing Adolescent Pregnancy programs. We launched G.R.U.F.F. (Girls Reading to Understanding Furry Friends), a partnership with FAAS (Friends of the Alameda Animal Shelter), where our elementary girls read aloud to the shelter animals. Our new program is a win-win for both organizations, as our girls get to practice their reading skills in front of a non-judgmental audience, and the shelter animals benefit from hearing calm voices and having human interaction.

One of our goals at Girls Inc. of the Island City is to continue to partner with wonderful organizations in and around our community to bring impactful and innovative programs to our girls. Our new partnership with FAAS, continued work with the school district, and the unwavering support we receive from the community allow us to do that and we look forward to the next year to see what opportunities await us. Because of you all, we have the power to make a difference and we thank you for supporting Girls Inc. of the Island City.

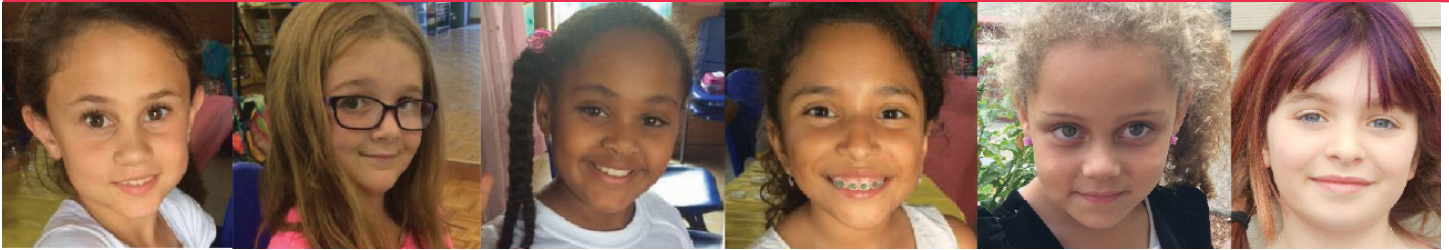

GIIC collaborated with FAAS (Friends of the Alameda Animal Shelter) to create a fun and innovative reading program that gives girls the opportunity to practice reading in a non-judgmental environment while helping to socialize shelter animals.



Teens participated in **Eureka!**, our national five-year program that encourages girls to explore career paths in **STEM** while providing personal and professional development opportunities through workshops, activities, and internships.



She Votes



During the 2016 election season, girls participated in **She Votes**, a unique Girls Inc. National civic engagement program that taught the importance of civic participation, voting rights, suffrage, and the power of making a difference through government and voting.

GIIC teen participant, Mary Carmen, was named **Girls Inc. National Scholar**. Along with the honor, Mary Carmen received a \$20,000 scholarship.



Passport to Success: NaNoWriMo

As part of **Passport to Success**, a series of workshops that empowers teens by promoting college readiness, self-sufficiency, leadership, personal safety, and positive decision making; teens wrote a novel in 30 days during **National Novel Writing Month**. Alameda's Poet Laureate, Julia Park Tracey served as mentor.



Ethical Fashion Show 2017



Teens spent six weeks in intensive, hands-on workshops in design, patterning, sewing, and finishing. They also learned how to create a business plan; and to price, market, and sell their upcycled creations. The teens selected models and premiered their original designs on the **Ethical Fashion Show Runway**.

Alameda Island Kids



In 1981, at the request of the Alameda Unified School District, the Activity Center opened as a licensed child care service for families on school sites. Once again, Girls Inc. of the Island City responded to the needs of the community by providing a safe place for children during afterschool hours. In 2006, this program was renamed "Alameda Island Kids." It currently serves 361 children at Bay Farm, Earhart, Edison, Franklin, and Otis Elementary Schools. Alameda Island Kids before-school and after-school services are specially designed to provide age appropriate daily activities including organized games and sports, cooking experiences, science, dramatic play, arts and crafts, and much more. Activities are designed to develop social skills and build confidence.
