



AIK Registration Q & A

Q: How do I register?

A: Families can register for the 2022-2023 school year online through the AIK website. Registration does not guarantee a space. We build our enrollment from the registrations and build our waitlist once we reach our limit. Kindergarten registration starts at 7:00 am on March 11, 2022. 1st-5th grade registration starts on April 11, 2022, at 7:00 am. Once you fill in your information and pay the registration fee, you are done!

Q: How many children do you accept in AIK?

A: The number of children in our program varies per site. We anticipate going back to pre-COVID enrollment. Based on our state license, we can host between 56 and 70 children per school.

Q: How will I know if I get a spot?

A: We will contact you via email and use the address provided on your registration questionnaire. Please allow us one week to complete the registration process on our end and notify families of their placement.

Q: How much is the registration fee?

A: Registration is a non-refundable fee of \$55.00 per child.

Q: What if I don't get placement?

A: We will make contact with families and let you know where you stand on the waitlist. Our waitlist is fluid and changes are made weekly leading into the first week of school.

Q: Can I register at multiple schools?

A: You must be enrolled at the school you register for. Please verify the school before you complete your registration. Not doing so could jeopardize your space, as each site maintains a different list.

Q: When and how do I pay tuition?

A: Tuition invoices for August will be emailed the last week in July and payments are due before the first day of school. You will receive an invoice and payment link by the 15th of each month thereafter. The first and last month of care will be prorated. We will offer an optional auto-pay option for the 22-23 school year.

Q: Does AIK offer part-time care?

A: AIK does not offer part time care. We offer part-time schedules for our employees, and we find it difficult to staff qualified teachers for two and three-day schedules. You do not have to attend all five days to maintain enrollment.

Q: Does AIK provide tuition assistance?

A: AIK does not provide sibling discounts or tuition assistance. We are proud providers of the MCCYN program. All Military and US Coast Guard families can apply for childcare benefits at www.MilitaryChildCare.com. Our Provider Identification number is 3000067685.
